1 Day

Guwahati to Sangti Valley

The Gateway Opens

Your journey begins in Guwahati, Assam's lively capital. Soon, the plains slip away, replaced by winding forest roads. At Bhalukong, the entry into Arunachal Pradesh is marked with an inner line permit. The road climbs past Bomdila and Dirang until Sangti Valley welcomes you.

- ◀ **Sangti Valley: One of Arunachal's best-kept secrets**
- ◀ **Soak in the calmness of the hills as you enter the tranquil world of Bomdila**

2 Day

Sela Pass to Tawang

Crossing the Heavens

Ascend to the high Himalayan altitudes through war memorials and mountain passes. Reach Tawang by sunset, welcomed by its quiet charm and chilly air. Ride across the breathtaking Sela Pass, where snow and sky blend seamlessly.

En route spots:

- ◀ Sela Pass (13,700 ft.)
- ◀ En route visit Dirang Monastery (optional)
- ◀ Jaswant Garh Memorial—The legend of Rifleman Jaswant Singh lives here
- ◀ The first glimpse of Tawang town, nestled in the high Himalayas

3 Day

Edge of India

Bum La Adventure

Ride to the Indo-China border where nature meets history. High-altitude lakes and remote monasteries make this day unforgettable. Experience Madhuri Lake, framed by snow-capped peaks. On the return, step into the vast Tawang Monastery, the largest in India, where the monks' chants echo across centuries.

Landmarks of the day:

- ◀ **Bum La Pass (15,200 ft):** Feel the patriotism pulse in the cold air of Bum La Pass (Requires permit, subject to weather and road conditions)
- ◀ **Madhuri Lake:** Cinematic and serene (Requires permit, subject to weather and road conditions)
- ◀ **The timeless grandeur of Tawang Monastery**
- ◀ **By evening, the Tawang War Memorial glows with its Light & Sound show, bringing history to life (If available in the evening)**
- ◀ **Markets humming with mountain life**

Local sightseeing: 60-70 km

Tawang to Shergaon

Into the Orchards

Leaving Tawang behind, the road winds back through the valleys until it reaches Shergaon, a hidden Monpa village embraced by forests and orchards. Here, life slows down, and silence becomes the truest luxury.

- ◀ Orchard trails and village walks of Shergaon
- ◀ Visit the quiet Shergaon Monastery
- ◀ Authentic Monpa hospitality in a remote setting

Terms and Conditions

Introduction: Your Adventure with Brahmanic Trailss

Welcome to Brahmanic Trailss Pvt. Ltd.! We're thrilled you're considering embarking on a bike expedition or high-altitude Himalayan trek with us. These Terms and Conditions (T&Cs) constitute a legally binding agreement between you, the participant, and Brahmanic Trailss Pvt. Ltd.

By booking a trip with us, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agreed to these T&Cs.

1. Booking & Payment

How to Book

Bookings can be made via our official website [www.brahmanictrailss.com], by emailing us at [Your Email Address], or by calling [+91 9351012966 / 9983483688].

Participant Information

You must provide complete and accurate details including full name, date of birth, nationality, passport details (for international travel), emergency contact info, and medical history (see Section 4).

Deposit

A non-refundable deposit of 25% of the trip cost is required to confirm your booking. Your spot is secured only after the deposit is acknowledged via confirmation email.

Balance Payment

The remaining 75% must be paid at least 20 days before the trip. For bookings made within 30 days of departure, full payment is required immediately.

Payment Currency

All prices are in Indian Rupees (INR) unless otherwise stated. International clients may pay in USD as specified. Currency conversions are based on prevailing bank rates.

2. What's Included & What's Not

Included in Your Trip:

- All required permits and entry fees as per itinerary
- Accommodation on twin-sharing basis (hotels/guesthouses) or triple-sharing (homestays, tents, dorms)
- Meals (breakfast and dinner) as per itinerary
- Certified local trek/bike guides and support staff (cooks, porters, mechanics)
- Group medical and first-aid supplies
- Rental bikes with fuel as per itinerary
- Ground transport during expedition (jeeps/buses)
- Basic bike servicing (spare parts chargeable)

Not Included in Your Trip:

- International & domestic flights
- Visa fees, travel insurance, and medical expenses
- Personal expenses (laundry, internet, snacks, alcohol, bottled water)
- Tips for guides, porters, and support staff
- Charges for excess baggage
- Emergency evacuations or extended stays due to weather/political unrest
- Personal gear (trekking or biking)
- Optional activities not mentioned in the itinerary
- Bike rental security deposit (unless clearly included)

3. Cancellations & Refunds

Cancellation by Participant

All cancellations must be emailed to us. The refund amount is based on the date of receipt:

- 30+ days before departure: Loss of 25% deposit
- 20–30 days: 50% refund
- 7–20 days: 25% refund
- Less than 7 days: No refund

No refunds are offered for no-shows or voluntary withdrawal after trip commencement.

Cancellation by Brahmanic Trailss Pvt. Ltd.

We reserve the right to cancel due to low bookings, safety, or operational reasons. In such cases, you'll receive a full refund of payments made to us. We are not responsible for personal expenses like flights or visas.

4. Participant Health & Responsibilities

Physical Fitness & Medical Disclosure

High-altitude treks and biking expeditions require good physical fitness. You must disclose any medical conditions including surgeries, allergies, or chronic issues.

Medical Certificate

For treks above 3,500 meters, a **medical fitness certificate** issued within 45 days of departure is mandatory. Failure to submit it may result in cancellation without refund.

Right to Refuse Participation

We reserve the right to deny or remove participants deemed unfit or unsafe for the trip. The decision of the trip leader is final.

Acclimatization & Gear

You must follow all acclimatization guidelines and bring personal gear listed in our checklist. Disregarding instructions may result in trip removal.

Behavior & Conduct

Respect local customs and the environment. Disruptive behavior may result in removal from the trip without refund.

5. Mandatory Travel Insurance

Required Coverage

Your travel insurance must cover:

- Emergency medical treatment
- Helicopter evacuation (if required)
- Trip cancellation or interruption
- Personal liability
- Lost/delayed baggage
- Trekking/biking coverage up to your trip altitude

Proof & Responsibility

Proof must be submitted **at least 30 days before departure**. Lack of proper coverage may lead to cancellation without refund. We are not liable for losses due to **inadequate or missing insurance**.

6. Risk, Assumption of Risk & Limitation of Liability

Adventure travel involves inherent risks, including but not limited to: altitude sickness, rough terrain, accidents, and limited medical care.

- All participants must sign a Liability Waiver before the trip.
- Our total liability is limited to the amount paid for your trip.
- We are not responsible for third-party services (e.g., airlines, hotels).

7. Force Majeure

Events beyond our control—natural disasters, war, strikes, epidemics, or government actions—constitute force majeure.

- In such cases, we are not liable for delays, losses, or cancellations.
- We may offer credit or alternate dates, but refunds are not guaranteed.

8. Complaints & Grievances

- During the trip: Immediately inform your trip leader.
- Post-trip: Email unresolved complaints within 30 days. We will respond after a fair investigation.

9. Data Protection & Privacy

We collect personal data to plan logistics, obtain permits, and ensure your safety.

- Your data is protected under the IT Act 2000 and DPDP Act 2023.
- We do not share your data for marketing without consent.

10. Governing Law & Jurisdiction

These Terms & Conditions are governed by Indian Law.

All disputes fall under the **exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Jaipur, Rajasthan.**

11. Severability

If any clause is ruled unenforceable, the rest of the terms will remain fully valid and enforceable.

12. Amendments

Brahmanic Trailss Pvt. Ltd. reserves the right to amend these T&Cs at any time. Updated terms will be posted on our website. It is your responsibility to stay informed.

13. Motorcycle Expedition: Additional Key Terms

Motorcycle Allocation

Motorcycle models may vary from promotional visuals. A comparable replacement may be provided if needed. No extensions or refunds are given for breakdowns or if you're unable to ride. Report issues immediately.



Insurance & Security Deposit

A **refundable deposit of INR 8,000 to INR 20,000** is mandatory. Damage costs will be deducted from this amount. In case of **loss or theft**, you are liable for the **full deposit**, regardless of insurance. Riders with less than **2 years of experience** are liable for the **entire motorcycle value**.

Damage & Recovery Charges

You are responsible for all damage beyond regular wear and tear. Vehicle recovery is charged at a **minimum of INR 15,000**, plus **INR 125/km** beyond the first 50 km (round trip).

Using Your Own Motorcycle

Your motorcycle must be **road-legal and in excellent condition**. We do not cover any costs or provide insurance for privately owned bikes.

Mandatory Documentation

You must carry a **valid passport, visa** (if applicable), and both **national and international driving licenses**. Failure to provide valid documents = **no motorcycle, no tour, no refund**.

Support Vehicle & Group Size

Support van is included only if the group has 4 motorcycles or 6 participants.

If not met, your options:

- Proceed without the van
- Switch to self-guided tour
- Request full refund

We are not liable for any **travel-related expenses** if a tour is canceled due to low numbers.

Booking Transfers

Bookings can be transferred to another eligible rider with **prior approval**. Both parties share liability for any outstanding payments.
